It is also possible that פרע also spawned the word prank – whose earlier usages were as show off – display. Also הרע [trumpet blast] to [the elephant's] trunk. (64 בער [bow, bend] – cringe - ?] Also רעם [bad] to raunchy [orig. inferior, low class, bad shape] בער [burn] to brand [as in branding iron] and burn - של bitter – to mourn - גער - bor [grain, corn] to – barn

Also דאג [worry] to daunt - - funk [cowering fear] from דאג [fear] - Dangle [original Scand. Meaning – to sway in the wind] might derive from דגל degel [flag]. צב [stand] to - stand (פרא] - [wild] to frenzy, frenetic]

Ernest Klein and Alcalay have a חרט as denoting turn and an Arabic חרט term is listed as – turn on a lathe – but I have not found any trace of a biblical or even PBH link between חרט and turning. If there does exist such a connection, then חרט would probably be the source of wrench - whose early meaning was – turn, twist – and with an N infix

Consider also snip [trim the ends] from סוף [end] and snare from שורה shurah [line]

Perhaps the word cling derives from עלוקה alukah [leech] – an animal that attaches and clings to flesh and to other materials – by ayin to C/K transformation

Gaunt may be related to gutted – and derive from YIN khutz [out]
