Note as well that the Lat. Sedeo, sedere [sit] probably derives from Hebrew  $\neg w$  sheiv [sit] and therefore it seems possible that the Lat. sidero Element of con – sidero [consider, regard] derives from the  $\neg w$  element of  $\neg w \neg$  [think, consider]

The Hebrew word עשב eisev [grass, herb] was likewise withered – albeit radically so - into the Egyptian [blue dye yielding] wedjet – and also ultimately into the English vegetation terms – veget – wort – weed – herb – woad – wattle – Ger. watte [cotton] – Ger. wurz and likely also into the Latin hortus [vegetable, garden] and aspalax [herb] and the ancient Grk. isatis. See also caespes – pg...Also the woad words – Ital. guado – Fr. guede – Dan. vaid and many other similar Gmnc. terms.[ Perhaps Span. vega = valley or plain with much vegetation – but see also also Lat. vitrum [woad] in a rare radical 3 letter dissimilation withering.???] - Also Lat. gossypium = cotton, herb . The willow branch/ shoot term osier [Lat.auserium] derives either from עשב or from the related term ע eitz [tree] and the osier synonym – withe is apparently related to the weed and woad terms. Probably also Ger. weiden [to graze, pasture]

Notice also the possibility of a link between להב flame and כשב fire - כשב sheep [used as money exchange in very ancient times] and קשיטא – כסיתא ksitah [money]
